General Notice

The Village of Bellaire (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **Village of Bellaire** village office's located at **202 N Bridge St, Bellaire, MI 49615**, until **Monday June 24, 2024 at 9 a.m.** local time. At that time the Bids received will be **publicly** opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Mechanical Screen Installation

- 1. Installation of a new approximately 450 sqft Headworks building to contain a mechanical screen and bypass channel with bar screen. Scope of work to include mechanical, piping, plumbing, HVAC, electrical, gas detection, and controls/blower structure.
- 2. Screen to include washer / compactor unit including installation roll away dumpster for wasted solids. Dumpster provided by owner.

Aeration System Installation

1. Aeration system removal and replacement including removal of all surface aerators and appurtenances, installation of two positive displacement blowers, aeration header piping, aeration manifolds, and aerator units to be provided and installed.

<u>Site Work</u>

- 1. Demolition of existing Influent Diversion Channel and construction of a new Diversion Structure. Structure to include slide gates, aluminum grating, and connection to existing lagoon inlet piping.
- 2. Existing 10" DI pipe between Influent Manhole and the existing Influent Diversion Channel is to be abandoned.
- 3. 10" SDR 35 to be installed between Influent Manhole to Headworks Building influent screening channel and from the effluent screening channel to the proposed Influent Diversion Structure.
- 4. East and West Lagoon Biosolids removal and disposal; the WWTP is required to maintain operation with one primary lagoon taken offline at a time. Biosolids removal is to be coordinated with Aeration System Installation.
- 5. Miscellaneous berm repair as identified during biosolids removal, final locations to be field indicated and verified with Engineer.
- 6. Access drive reconstruction and site restorations.
- 7. Five (5) 2" PVC monitoring wells.
- 8. Site electrical demolition and new installation.
